Challenges and Barriers in achieving Transformation

- **There is considerable diversity and applications of livestock agriculture globally**
 - *133 million dairy farms globally*
 - *Specific solutions will be different for each business*

- **Knowledge exchange is a critical part of the solution though an ADDITIONAL step is required to achieve application into livestock farming systems to maximize the potential co-benefits**
 - *What can/do we have to do as livestock managers – C-Sequ*

- **Greatest barrier to implementation is confidence!**
 - *Technology development and adoption - ILM*
 - *Wanted -'Translators'*



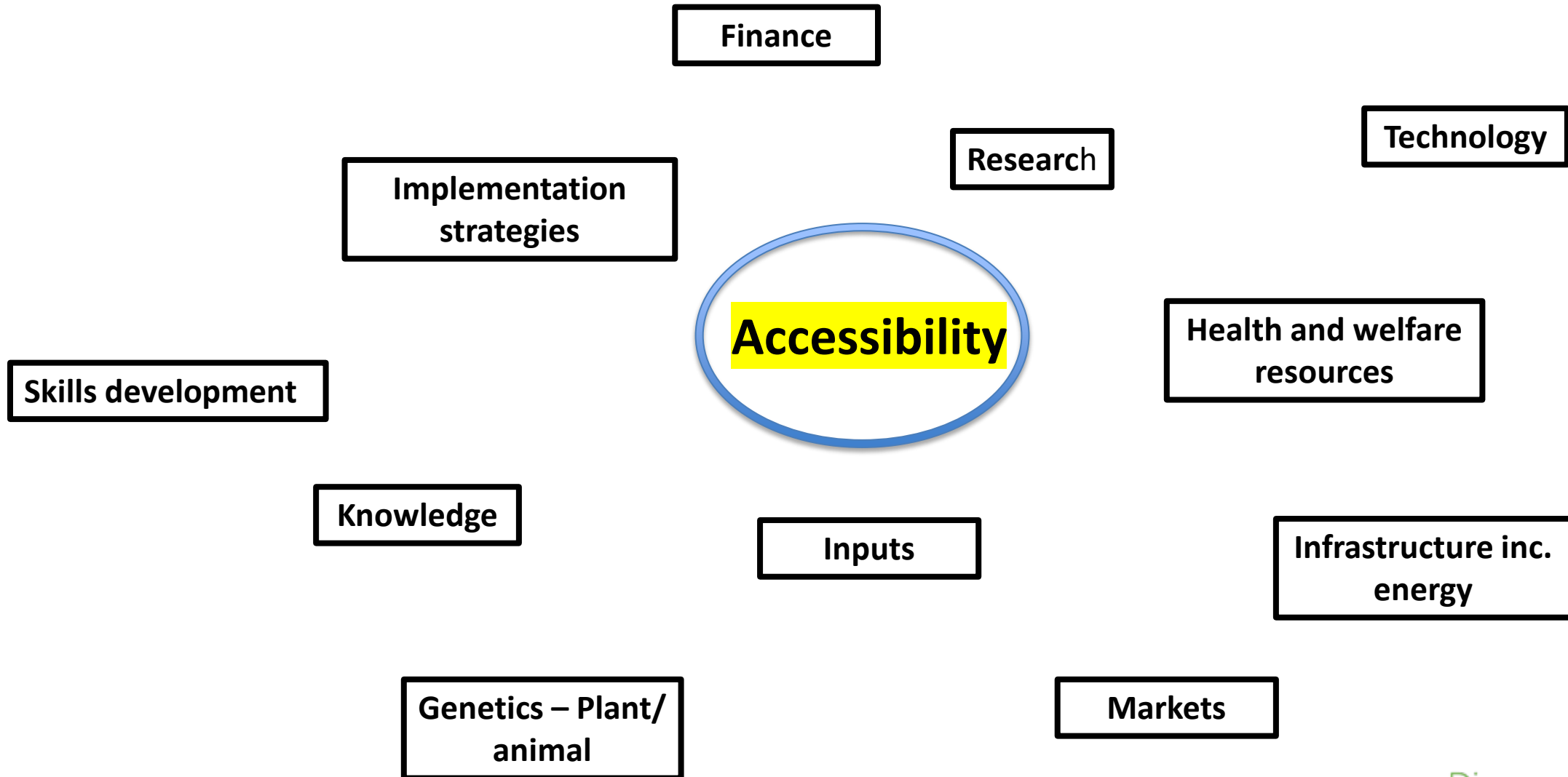
How can KJWP and UNFCCC Constituted Bodies or other actors help to address these challenges

- **Recognize the role and encourage collaboration and partnership with business**
 - Business can bring science and knowledge to life through implementation
 - PPP – FAO/GDP/GASL Dairy and GHG report - GRA relationship (Cattle Health / GHG study) – progress!
- **Encourage and support the adoption of quantification methodologies that recognize the co-benefits of adaptation and mitigation**
 - *IDF GHG LCA methodology*
- **Collaborate with those that can implement change at scale**
 - *DSF – 27% global milk production – 46% Formal milk*
 - *Dairy Asia – 14 Asian countries*
 - *GASL – Multi-stakeholder forum*
- **Acknowledge diversity recognizing the value add of livestock beyond purely production and emissions**
 - *FAO report (2019) “Climate action must not be at the expense of ending poverty and achieving 0 hunger by 2030”*
 - *X cutting opportunities – join the dots –maximize SDG value*
