This includes additional precautions to support staff at our production facilities, including temperature testing, cleaning and sanitizing procedures, prohibiting visitors from entering our facilities, prohibiting international travel, limiting domestic travel, adopting social distancing practices and offering shift flexibility to keep our major production facilities open.

Keeping the global food and agricultural system strong

We are working to ensure that global food supply chains remain strong, with open trade and functioning markets keeping food, feed, and agricultural inputs moving across borders. We are supporting support farmers, ranchers, and others along the food chain to keep operations going and maintain vital market connections to ensure a continuous food supply chain. Cargill will continue to play a role with other partners to advocate for open trade as an essential mechanism for keep the food and agricultural system strong.
