

Overview of the Codex MRL Setting Process for Pesticides

PROCESS CONCERNS National registration of AI or New Use Label requirement delays start of Codex process **CCPR** members and observers nominate Als for New Compound or New Use/Other evaluation No provision exists to check nomination data quality Als are added to the Codex Schedules and Priority Lists of Pesticides for Evaluation by JMPR ("placed in the queue") THEY WILL WAIT IN THE QUEUE UNTIL ALL REQUIRED DATA IS AVAILABLE Limited number of JMPR sessions and JMPR Experts Als are prioritized ("given a number") and placed on a limits the number of evaluations per cycle **Extraordinary Sessions increase** specific upcoming agenda, based on confirmation of data Submitters have no opportunity for a pre-submission the number of evaluations availability and a registered label; Call for Data follows discussion with JMPR Secretariat and/or Experts JMPR Experts conduct evaluation National assessments and MRLs, and trials that deviate too far from the label GAP are not considered **JMPR** Experts conduct evaluation for Extraordinary Session(s) Crop groups have been inconsistently applied by Experts JMPR held - Pesticides & Toxicology **Extraordinary Sessions** JMPR does not make use of the latest technologies for Committees review and discuss expand single-year efficient submission and evaluation of dossiers Experts' evaluations and submit capacity and output recommendations to CCPR No explanation given when MRLs are not recommended or crop group is not applied **CCPR** recommendations for CXL approvals published in CCPR report and appendices **CAC** approval of CCPR recommendations; CXLs officially established by
