- We pioneered the private sector's entry into level 3 municipal waterworks when there was none.
- We pioneered joint ventures to rehabilitate distressed, government-owned water districts.
- We pioneered bulk water supply projects by tapping surface river water and springs and designing modern filtration systems thereof.
- 4. Balibago has been proactive developing " out of the box" solutions to potable water shortage. Perfect example is when we laid out a 40-kilometer pipe line to source water from the main land to a nearby island that is a famous beach resort area.
- Presently, we are envisioning harvesting rain water from perennially flooded land basins and filtering this water to be potable.
