Elizabeth Kabakoyo, the leader of the World Food Forum National Chapter in Uganda, is not just a youth advocate in agriculture but also an ardent agro-ecological farmer. As the founder of Glowish Agro Solutions, she transforms agricultural waste into bio-fertilizer, supporting rural women farmers with indigenous maize seeds for food security. Elizabeth's expertise in vermiculture led to the creation of Eco-Organic Fertilizer, significantly boosting agricultural production and reducing the use of toxic inputs among smallholder farmers in Uganda. With a degree in Agriculture and Community Development, she has five years of handson experience in crop farming, training farmers, and organic fertilizer production. Elizabeth is a dynamic speaker in youth and women agriculture forums, having shared a platform with the president of Ireland at the 2023 World Food Forum flagship event. Recognized for her contributions, she received awards such as 3rd run up for the National Agricultural Award 2023 and acknowledgment as an outstanding rural woman in food production by Rural Women International. Additionally, Elizabeth is actively involved in initiatives like African Women Leaders in Agroecology (AWOLA) and is an alumna of the Young African Leaders Initiative (YALI) Regional Leadership Center East Africa – Nairobi Cohort 44 in Business and Entrepreneurship Track.

Glowish Agro Solutions

Glowish Agro Solutions collects agricultural waste from daily food market, farms, abattoir and Agro processing factories and processes this into liquid fertilizer packaged in one litre bottle and branded - Eco organic fertilizer. These are then sold to small/ large scale farmers, agricultural organizations and B2B like Agro dealers. The enterprise also conducts farmer trainings on soil health in rural areas.
